

Western District of Oklahoma
Changes to Petition to Enter Plea of Guilty
September 2012

1. The recency language in 30 (the phrase “or within two years after being released from prison,”) was removed.

2. To address issues regarding stacking of sentences, the following sentences were added to 32: “If you are pleading guilty to more than one count, you could receive the maximum sentence on each count of conviction running consecutively (C/S). See USSG § 5G1.2.”

3. To ensure that counsel addresses the issue of seriatim violations of supervised release conditions, the third sentence of 36 was revised to read: “Under certain circumstances there is no limit to the number of times supervised release can be revoked and another term of supervised release imposed.”

4. To address issues regarding conditional pleas, a new question was added to 40(b).
