

**ORDER**

On March 17, 2020, the Court entered G.O. 20-8 suspending the requirement that the United States Marshals Service effect personal service of process under Fed. R. Civ. P. 4(c)(3) or 28 U.S.C. § 1915(d). That suspension is hereby lifted. All other provisions of G.O. 20-8 shall remain in effect until further order of the Court.

On April 21, 2020, the Court issued G.O. 20-4.1 suspending in-person proceedings involving persons detained at the Grady County Law Enforcement Center (GCLEC) until May 11, 2020. In light of current conditions at GCLEC, the Court extends the suspension period until **June 1, 2020**. All other provisions of G.O. 20-4 and G.O. 20-4.1 shall remain in effect until further order of the Court.
