




2. The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention continues to recommend against large indoor gatherings, which limits the number of people who should be in the courthouse at the same time.
3. While the steps the Court has taken to keep court staff, parties, counsel, and jurors safe have thus far been effective, given the prevalence of cases and the severity of the community spread, the Court finds a greater restriction on the number of people interacting in-person with the Court continues to be warranted.

Therefore, the period of delay resulting from continuances implemented as a result of this Order will be excluded under the Speedy Trial Act, as the Court specifically finds that the ends of justice served by ordering continuances outweigh the best interests of the public and each defendant to a speedy trial. *See* 18 U.S.C. § 3161(h)(7)(A).
