

## TRANSCRIPT RATES

Maximum transcript rates per page are set at the national level for all federal district courts by the Judicial Conference of the United States. The current maximum rates per page are shown below. *If you desire to have daily copy or any other extraordinary court reporter services during trial, you must so notify the Chief Deputy Court Clerk a minimum of two weeks before the date the case is scheduled to be called for trial.*

<p><b>Ordinary Transcript (30 day)</b> A transcript to be delivered within 30 calendar days after receipt of an order.</p>	\$3.65	\$0.90	\$0.60
<p><b>14-Day Transcript</b> A transcript to be delivered within 14 calendar days after receipt of an order.</p>	\$4.25	\$0.90	\$0.60
<p><b>Expedited Transcript (7 day)</b> A transcript to be delivered within 7 calendar days after receipt of an order.</p>	\$4.85	\$0.90	\$0.60
<p><b>3-Day Transcript</b> A transcript to be delivered within 3 calendar days after receipt of an order.</p>	\$5.45	\$1.05	\$0.75
<p><b>Daily Transcript</b> A transcript to be delivered on the calendar day following receipt of the order (regardless of whether that calendar day is a weekend or holiday), prior to the normal opening hour of the clerk's office.</p>	\$6.05	\$1.20	\$0.90
<p><b>Hourly Transcript</b> A transcript of proceedings to be delivered within 2 hours from receipt of the order.</p>	\$7.25	\$1.20	\$0.90
<p><b>Realtime Transcript</b> A draft unedited transcript produced by a certified realtime reporter as a byproduct of realtime to be delivered electronically during proceedings or immediately following receipt of the order.</p>	One feed <sup>2</sup> , \$3.05 per page; two-to-four feeds, \$2.10 per page; five or more feeds, \$1.50 per page. <sup>2</sup> A realtime "feed" is the electronic data flow from the court reporter to the computer of each person or party ordering and receiving the realtime transcription in the courtroom.
